

THERE ARE LOTS OF DIFFERENT TYPES OF **CHANNELS**! ON YOUTUBE. A PERSON WITH A YOUTUBE CHANNEL IS CALLED A YOUTUBER. WHICH YOUTUBERS DO YOU WATCH?

**Viogs** — A *vlog* is a video **journal**<sup>2</sup>. A person who makes them is called a *vlogger*. They usually make videos about their lives. Some vloggers make videos about films, jokes and **pranks**<sup>3</sup>, or **fashion**<sup>4</sup> and **make-up**<sup>5</sup>.

**Let's Play** – A *let's player* is a YouTuber who makes videos about playing games. They can play any game, but the most popular game for YouTube is *Minecraft*.

**Streaming**<sup>6</sup> — If someone makes their vlog or let's play series **live**<sup>7</sup>, they're called a *streamer*. Streams are usually longer than normal videos, and you can talk to the streamer with a **chat**<sup>8</sup> **box**<sup>9</sup>.

Jiří Král: A Czech let's player who sometimes makes vlogs about his life.



Teri Blitzen: A Czech vlogger who makes videos about make-up and fashion in Czech and in English.



Aira Plays Games: An American let's player who makes lots of cute<sup>10</sup> and funny game videos.



**vlogbrothers:** Two American brothers, John and Hank Green, who make vlogs about life, **news**<sup>11</sup>, jokes, and other topics.

TIP: English-speaking YouTubers often talk quite fast, but don't **be scared**<sup>12</sup>. They often have **subtitles**<sup>13</sup> to help you understand. Even if you don't understand everything, you can learn a lot of English by watching videos. It's great practice.
